The Situation

A seller believed buyers would come from online portals alone.

The Strategy

We expanded the campaign to include:

- Database buyer follow-up
- Targeted social media campaigns
- Local exposure and direct buyer follow-up
- Nurture plans for enquiries and inspections

The Result

By increasing buyer reach and actively managing enquiries, we generated more inspections than a typical campaign.

More inspections led to more competition, which in turn led to stronger offers.

The Bottom Line

The strongest buyer is rarely the first. They are created through competition.
