Real Estate Market Trends - NOVEMBER

Statewide rental squeeze continues — according to the latest REIQ report, Queensland's rental vacancy rate remains at 1%, meaning ongoing pressure for tenants and very steady demand for rental properties.

South Burnett & Kingaroy remain solid for buyers, sellers and investors Kingaroy's median house price has risen to about A\$504,000 (≈ 25 % growth YoY), with units around A\$315,000 (≈ 20 % growth). Houses are still selling quickly (most under 3–4 weeks), and rentals remain strong with yields attractive to landlords.

Rural and lifestyle-block demand is surging recent valuations show the median residential land value in South Burnett is up ~57 % from 2021, while rural-residential land (acreage/lifestyle lots) has jumped over 70 % in value. For buyers seeking space, lifestyle or investment, this market remains a standout.

Regional appeal remains high as housing affordability and low supply continue to drive people toward regional Queensland, North and South Burnett remains well-positioned versus metro markets.

LIVESTOCK UPDATE - NOVEMBER 2025

PRIVATE & PADDOCK SALES

Private and paddock sales have continued well throughout the month, whether that be bulls, cows and calves, heifers or on Auctions Plus.

Check out our website for what livestock listings we have available currently.

SALEYARD ACTIVITY

- Good prices have given producers continued confidence to sell, with prices picking up even more
 towards the end of the month with the recent rain and promise of more to fall throughout the next
 season.
- Feeders & processor markets held up throughout the month with a strong increase at the end of the month. The 18/11 Murgon sale saw some of the best export prices it has ever seen. Bullocks topped \$2,500/hd, light store cows making up to \$3.62/kg for \$1,100/hd and averaging \$3.40/kg. 400-500kg Cows topped at \$4.60/kg for \$2,200/hd and averaged \$3.64/kg. A beautiful line of red Brahman cows (pictured with agent Chris Crouch) topped the heavy cow market at \$4.30/kg for \$2,600/hd. Coolabunia saw smaller amounts of export cattle available at its monthly sale, but prices still held firm across all descriptions. Heavy bulls averaged \$2,700/hd for the month at both yards, with lighter bulls averaging \$1,800/hd.



The steer market is still as strong as ever, with light steers averaging at \$5.02/kg for the month and topping at \$5.90/kg at the 18/11 Murgon Sale. Two pens of black Brangus and Charolais steers averaged at 250kg made \$5.78/kg at this sale. Vendor Jed McCoy from Pazdash Grazing, Mt Perry couldn't be happier with the result, praising his agent Chris Crouch for all of his efforts and to the team on such a great sale.



- Feeder steers averaged \$4.90/kg and heavy steers averaged \$4.80/kg for the month.
- The heifer market saw a welcome increase for an average of around \$4.00/kg across all weight brackets for the month, with the top price being \$4.80/kg for a pen of light heifers at the 18/11 Murgon Sale.
- · Cows & calves are still back a bit compared to the rest of the market, averaging \$1,550/unit this month.
- Some extremely happy vendors and agents alike across the region with these prices!

FEATURE FEMALE SALE

Our 2025 Feature Female Sale was a great success, with plenty of quality weaner and yearling heifers, joiner heifers, PTIC heifers and cows, and cows and calves on offer. The team yarded 400hd from across the region which were sold at a \$/hd value. The cows & calf units averaged at \$2,000/unit, with a lovely pen of Droughtmasters topping at \$2,300/unit. PTIC cows & heifers topped at \$2,475/hd for an average of \$1,900/hd. Joiner, yearling and weaner heifers averaged \$1,000/hd for a top of \$2,275/hd.

We are happy with how the sale went and are aiming to hold one each year at the same time of year to offer producers the opportunity to purchase some quality replacement or starter breed stock. Mark this in your calendars for the future!

SEASONAL CONDITIONS & SUPPLY

Plenty of good rainfall and a few wild storms have fallen across the region this month, filling dams and bringing paddock conditions up and allowing pastures to regenerate.

Sale Record Smashed at Cream of the Crop Female Sale - 29 November!



Record Top Price heifer - Bryvonlea Sunshine 2841 (PP) selling for \$48,000 to Vitwood Droughtmasters.



Vale View Inga 2 (PP) sold for \$23,000 to Vitwood Droughtmasters.

The 12th Annual Cream of the Crop Sale delivered outstanding results over the weekend, with 49 of 51 heifers sold for a gross of \$309,000 and a strong average of \$6,306.

Inaugural vendors Brian and Yvonne Heck of Bryvonlea Droughtmasters enjoyed a standout day, with their heifer *Bryvonlea Sunshine 2841 (PP)* breaking the sale record at \$48,000, purchased by David Torrisi of Vitwood Droughtmasters. Bryvonlea finished with a \$28,500 average for their two heifers.

Dave, Colleen and Mac Smith also recorded a memorable result, selling *Vale View Inga 2 (PP)* to Vitwood for \$23,000 and averaging \$8,500 across their five heifers.

RSVP and Sylvan Springs, the largest vendors, achieved the third-highest price with RSVP Unmistakable selling to Vitwood for \$10,000, averaging \$5,833 for nine heifers.

Major Droughtmasters topped at \$9,000 and averaged \$6,333 for their trio, all purchased by David and Tavis Hartwig.

True Blue Droughtmasters recorded a top of \$8,000 and averaged \$5,900 for their five heifers.

Vitwood Droughtmasters, operating through Mitch Jackson of Elders Murgon, secured five lots at an impressive average of \$18,800, including the sale's top three lots and one heifer each from Nindethana and Rangeview Droughtmasters.
